The Central Ontario Railway, a world in miniature, depicts Canadian railroading in the late 1950's during the transition from steam to diesel locomotives. It is an "O" Scale (1/4"= 1 ft.) model railroad located in a 103' by 32' room with trains traveling over 4,000 feet of track, connecting two major cities, each with full yard and engine facilities. Several smaller towns and villages are located along the way and a branchline will serve a busy port where lake freighters regularly dock. Canadian National and Canadian Pacific trains appear regularly on Central Ontario track.

Come and spend an afternoon with us and see one of Canada's largest model railways under reconstruction. Enjoy the fun of model railroading.
